#### PRINTABLE BOOK

This handy printable book is a great way to review what was learned.

And it can be easily referenced at any time!

- K.RF.1a: Follow words from left to right, top to bottom, and page-by-page.
- K.RF.1b: Recognize that spoken words are represented in written language by specific sequences of letters.
- **K.RF.1c:** Understand that words are separated by spaces in print.

#### **Materials Needed:**

- Printable book pages
- Scissors
- Stapler

#### **Preparation:**

- Print copies of the printable book pages for each student.
- Gather the needed materials in an appropriate area.

#### **Steps to Success:**

- 1. Have students carefully cut along the dotted line that runs across the center of the page.
- 2. Have the students fold the book pages along the solid fold line that runs vertically down the center of the page.
- 3. Assist students in stapling the pages together.






